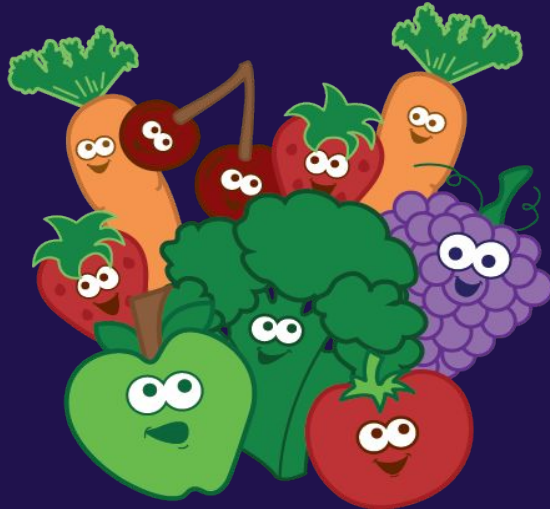
Let's Talk Math...

Cell phones may only be used for academic tasks **with staff permission.**



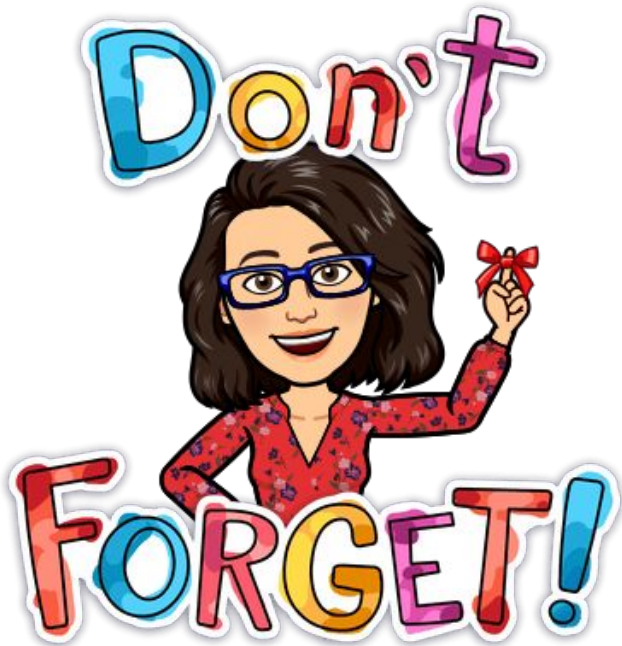


***you are to WALK to your bus, not run. Be mindful of those around you.**

Let's make Clearview THE place to be!

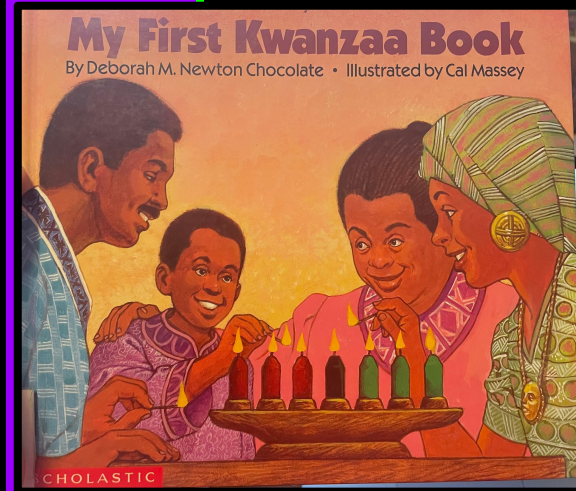
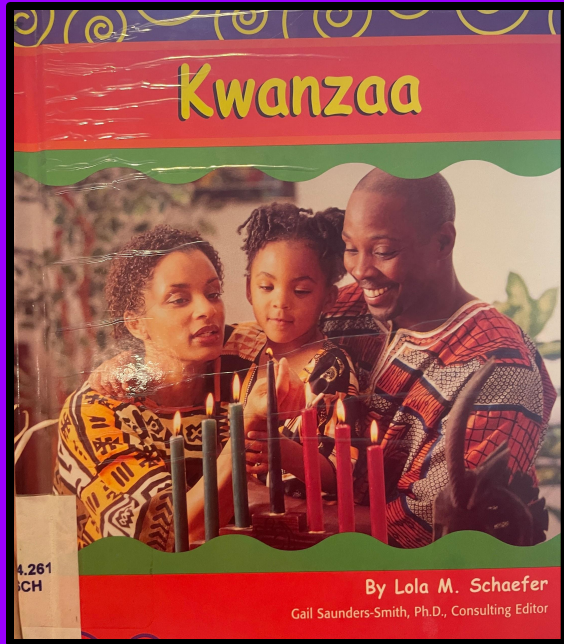
