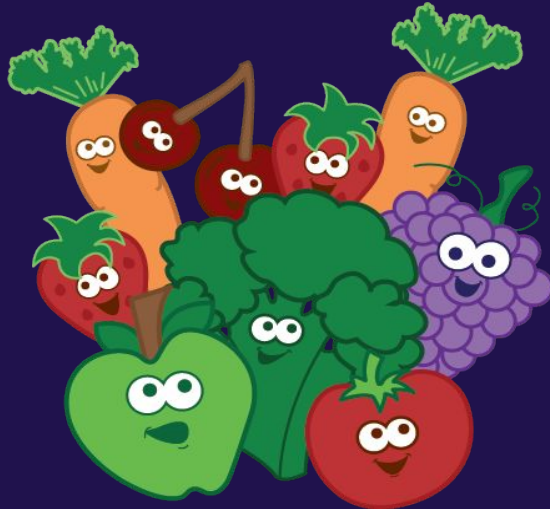


Wear Pink Wednesdays We encourage you all to wear pink on Wednesdays to show that you take a stand against bullying!

Cell phones may only be used for academic tasks **with staff permission.**





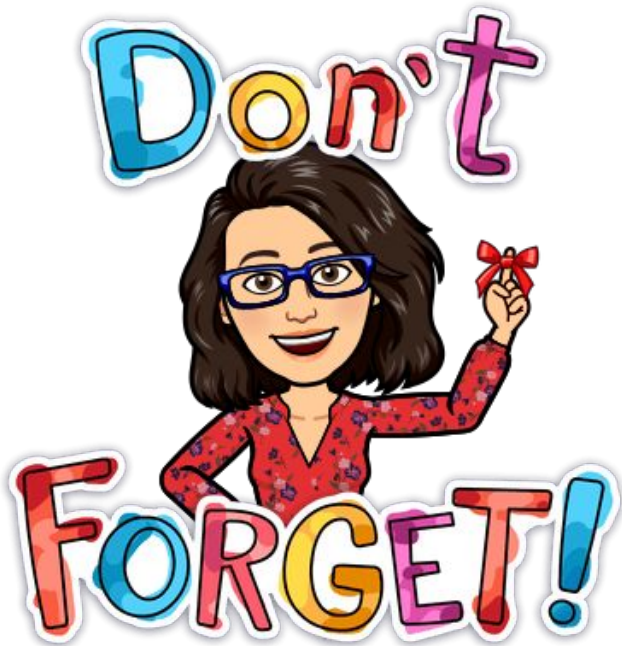


**\*you are to WALK to your bus, not run. Be mindful of those around you.**

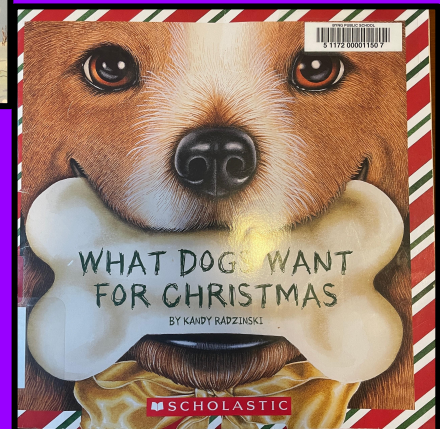
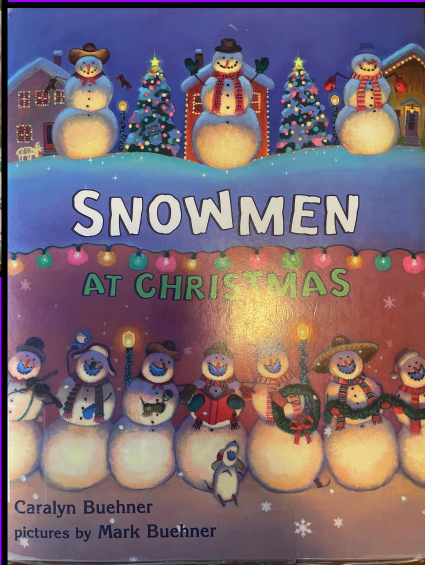
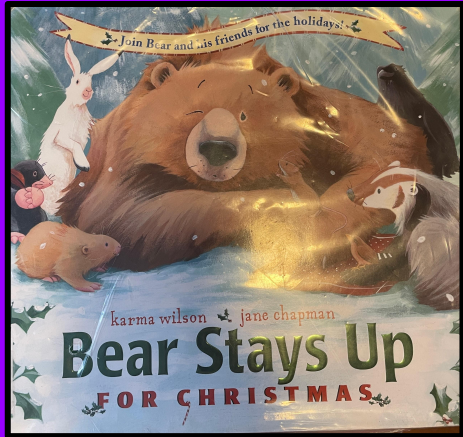
