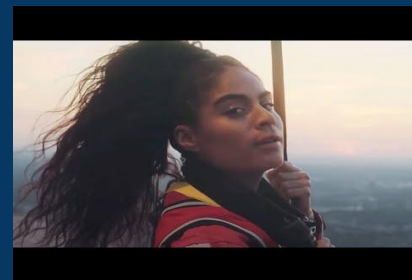

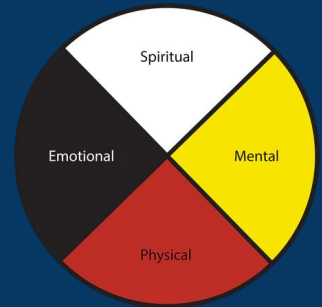
Please stand for the singing of O Canada (please pick one)

If you need help, come to me.

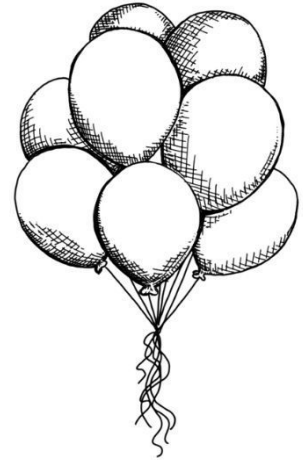

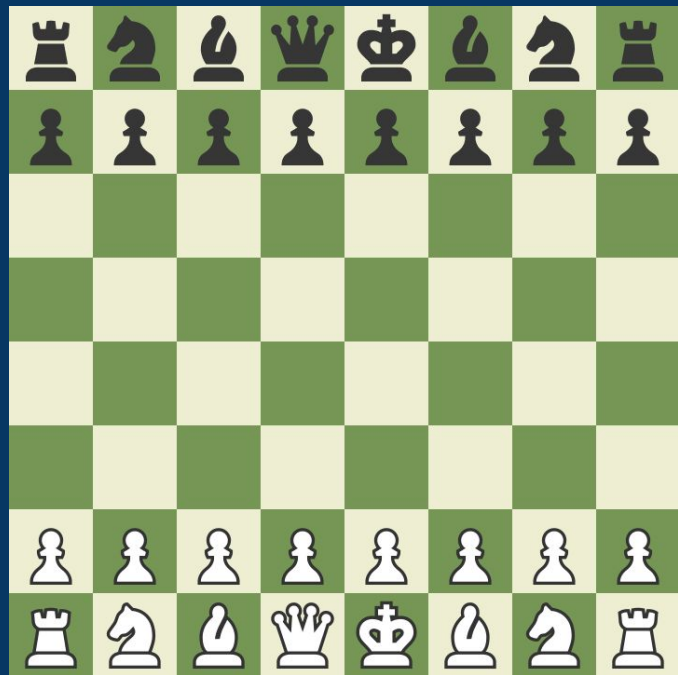

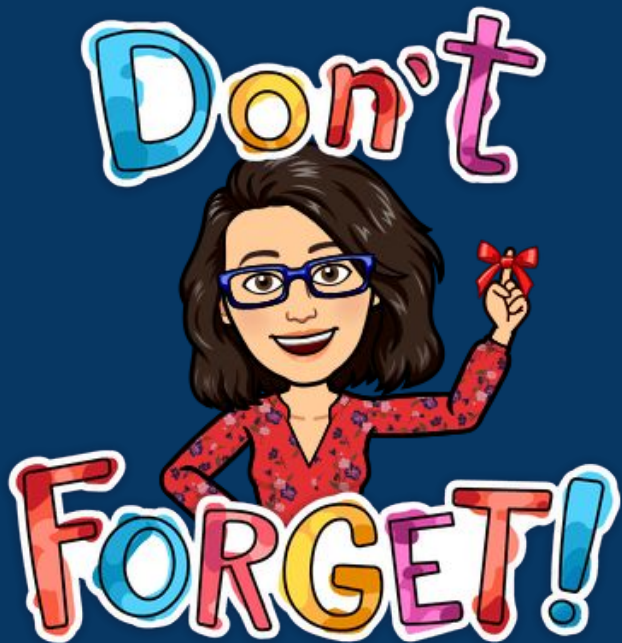

Who is our Mystery Reader?



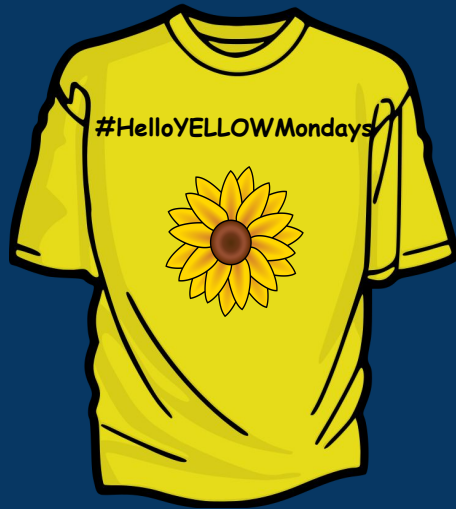
This week our Mystery Reader is Lupita Nyong'o. She is the author of Sulwe.
