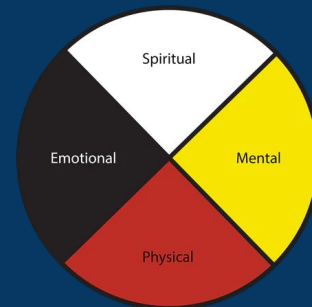

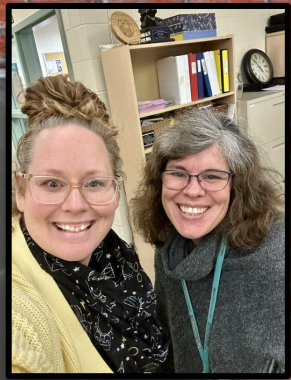

A quick message from Mrs. Saunders and Mrs. Harrison...

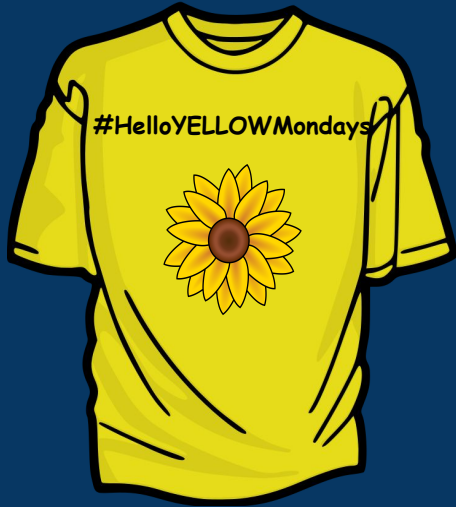
Thanks for an awesome week last week. We loved to see everyone playing cooperatively at recess, even when we needed to close the field. Keep being kind and having fun!

We encourage you all to wear pink on Wednesdays to show that you take a stand against bullying!



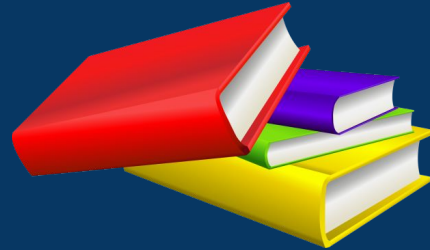

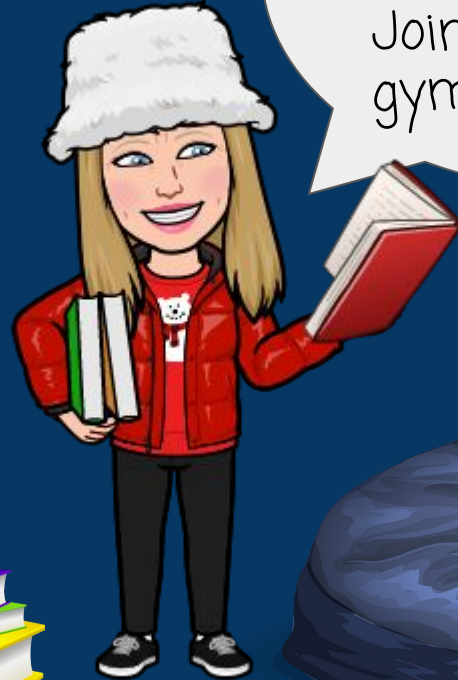
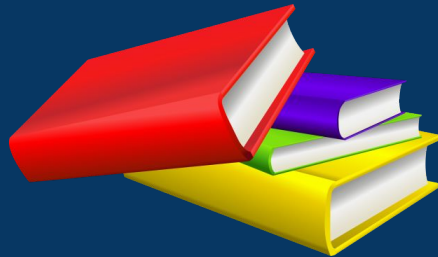


This Thursday is a big day in our den! It is COMFY COZY DAY, our first PIZZA DAY and it is the READ-A-THON!

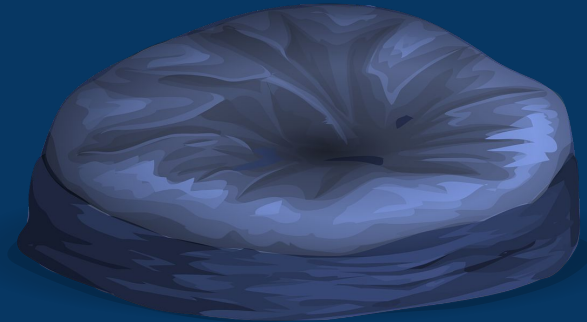





We are finding that some are losing their special cards that mean so much to them when this happens.

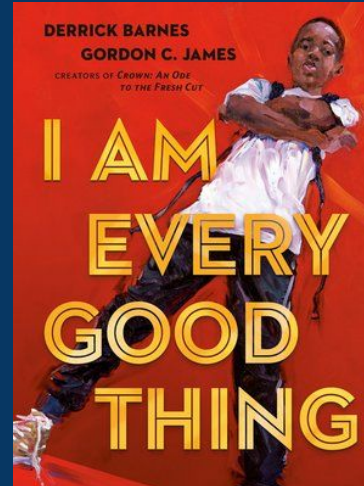
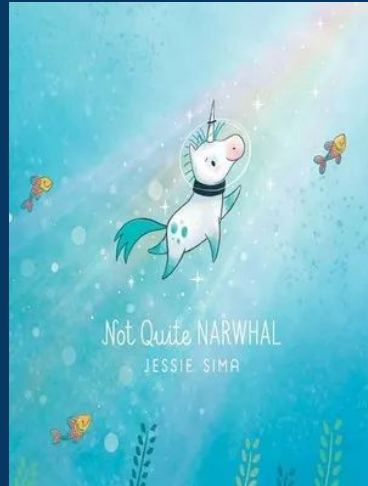
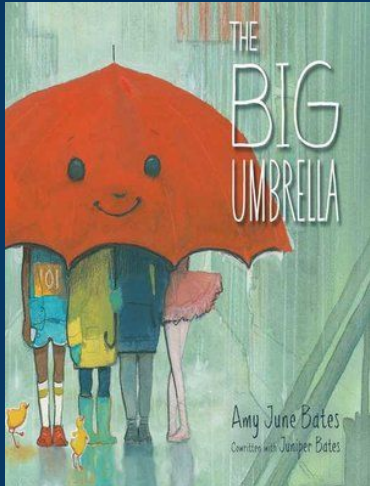
