



NO pushing or shoving is allowed. We keep our hands and feet to ourselves so we can all have the safe and fun recess we deserve!


Make good choices with the games that you play as they need to be fair and encourage all to play nicely!

We are finding that some are losing their special cards that mean so much to them when this happens.




