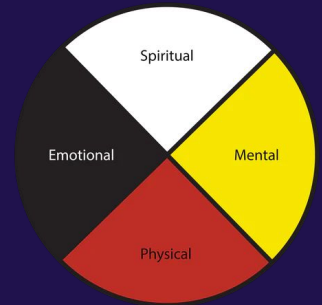

We are all different, but we all deserve respect.

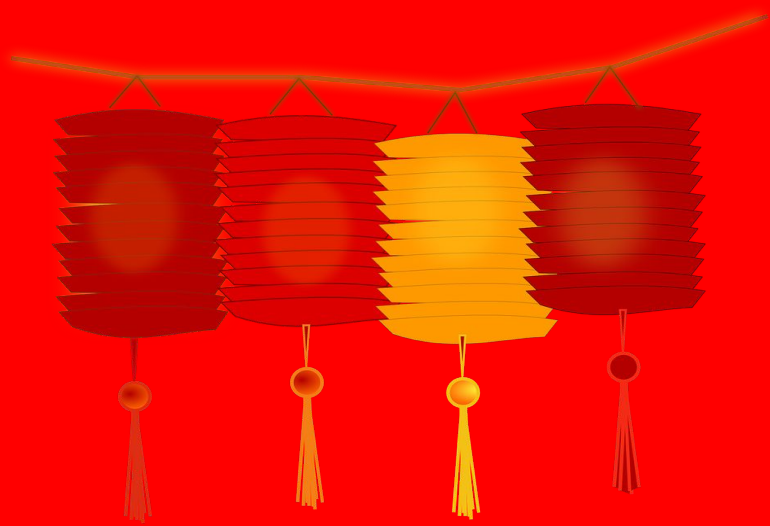
