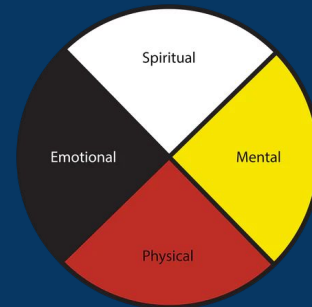

If you need help, come to me.

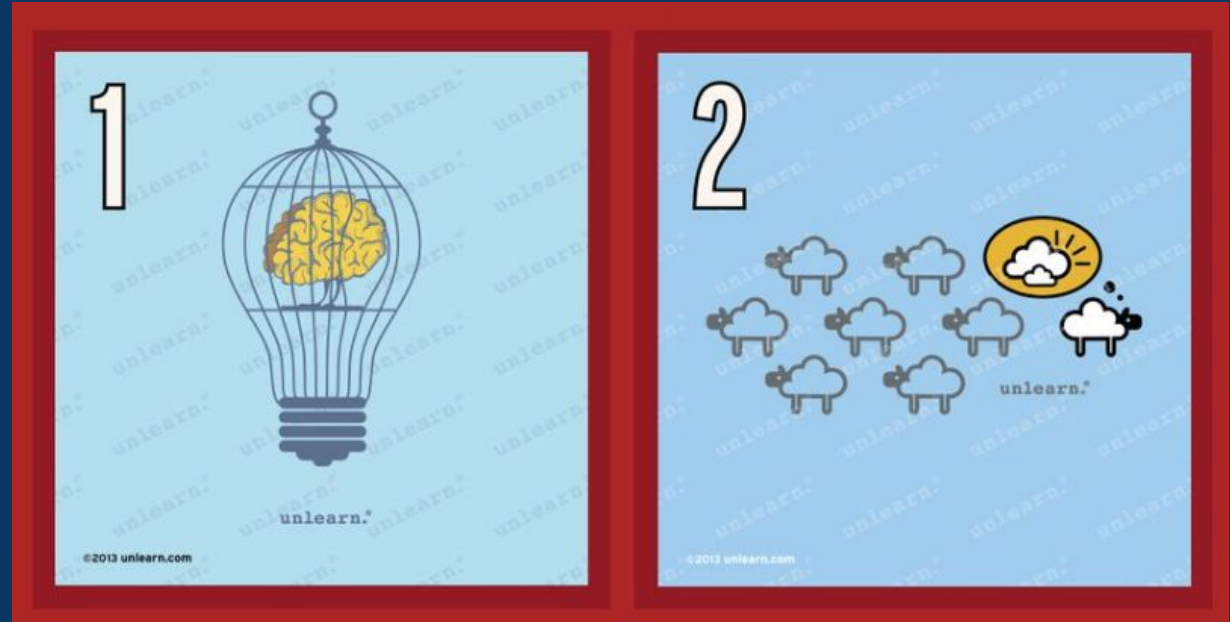
If I think you need help, I'm getting involved.

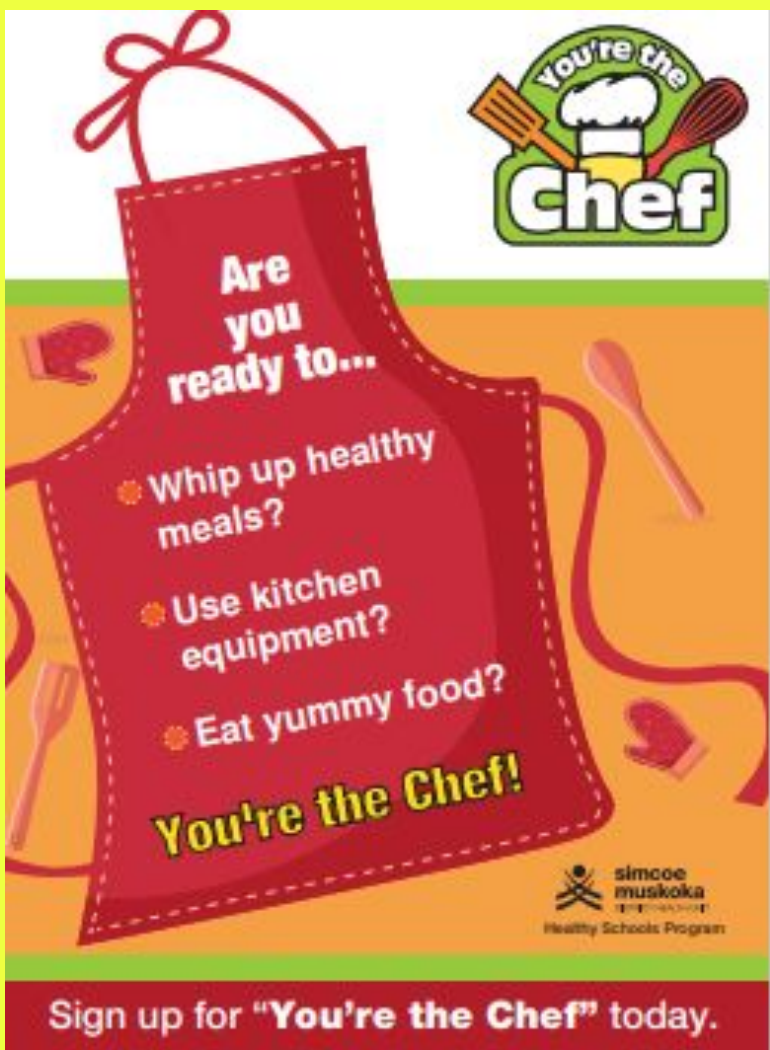


Junior Volleyball!!!

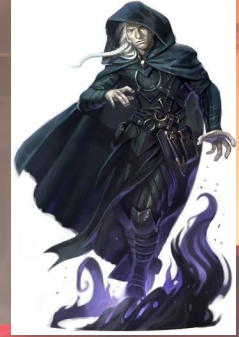

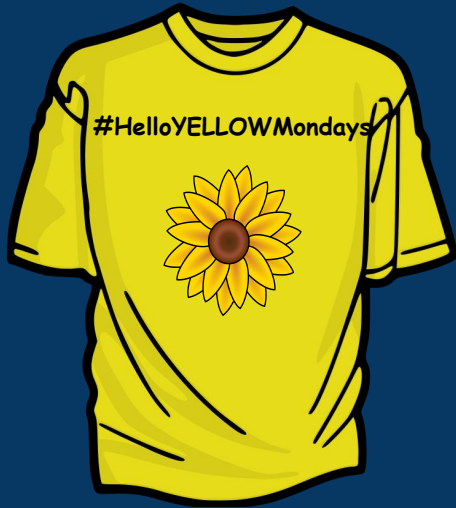
