

We begin this week's focus by sharing the Historically Black Anthem and showcase some of the work that classes are doing...














Don't forget Wolfpack to take a look as we present our Reading Journey activity for the month of February!!!

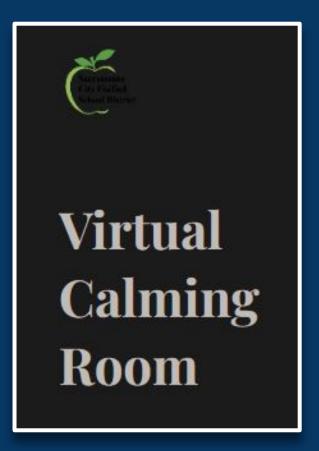
To all our Wolfpack for returning after a wonderful weekend to learn with us again! Mystery Reader (Repeat from last week)
