If you need help, come to me.


If I think you need help, I'm getting involved.



When we do this we can all have a fun recess where everyone feels safe and respected.

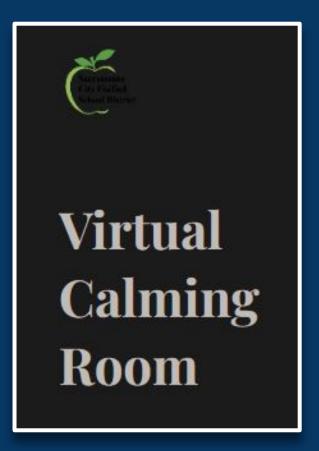
