
Additional Resources

Viola Desmond was designated a national historic person in 2017.

In 1946, Halifax businesswoman Viola Desmond confronted the racism that African-Nova Scotians routinely faced when she refused to move from her seat in the "whites-only" section of the Roseland Theatre, formerly located here. For this, she was arrested, jailed overnight, and fined. Her unsuccessful appeal to the Supreme Court of Nova Scotia attracted broad attention. It confirmed for African-Canadians that the law did not protect them and sparked their activism.

Desmond's resistance to racial discrimination was an important milestone in Canada's human rights history and an inspiration for the civil rights movement in this country.






We have to close the snow hill that is to the left of the portables near the SCI entrance.


Also, if you want to play on the snow hill you need to have snowpants on.
