

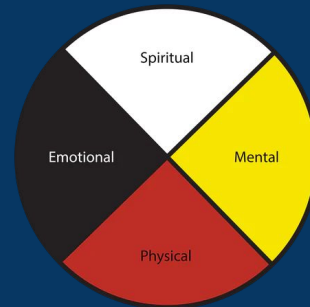

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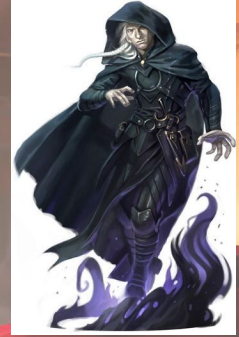

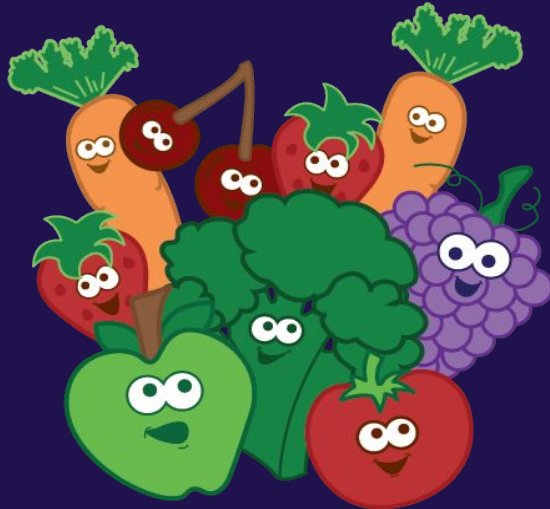
A reminder that when you arrive on the school yard in the morning, cell phones are to be put away in your bags.

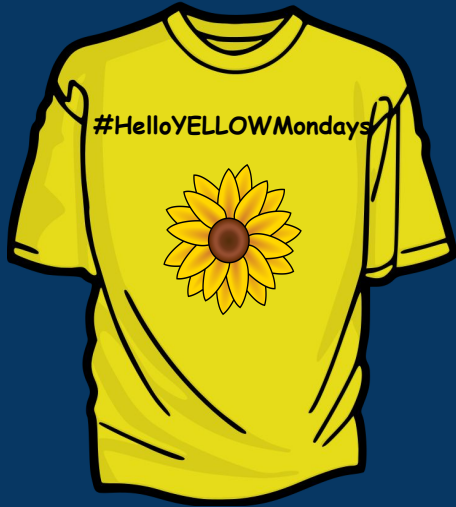
