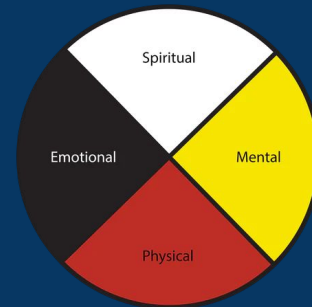

If I think you need help, I'm getting involved.















Literacy Tournament of Books (next slide)

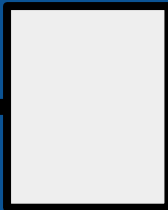
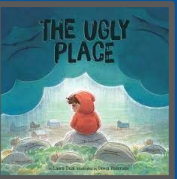
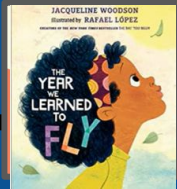
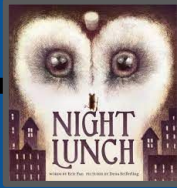

Tournament of Books 2023



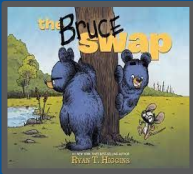
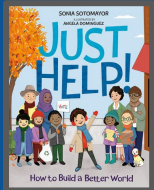
The 2023 Tournament of Books

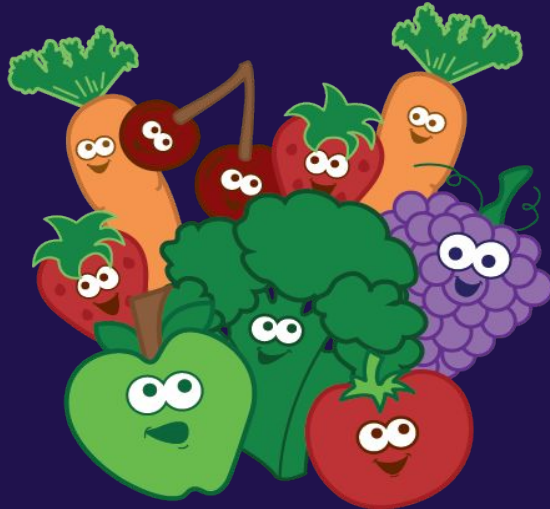
Bring your buckets down after 2nd break

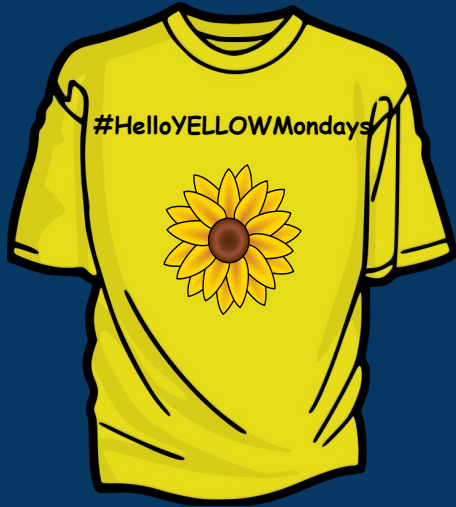
