




With the new month of February upon us, we look to recognize Black History Month here at Clearview Meadows.



On Friday when we have our Read A Thon we will be having some special guests join us. Let's show them how amazing our Wolfpack is!






We have to close the snow hill that is to the left of the portables near the SCI entrance.
