Clue 1: I am an actress and author.

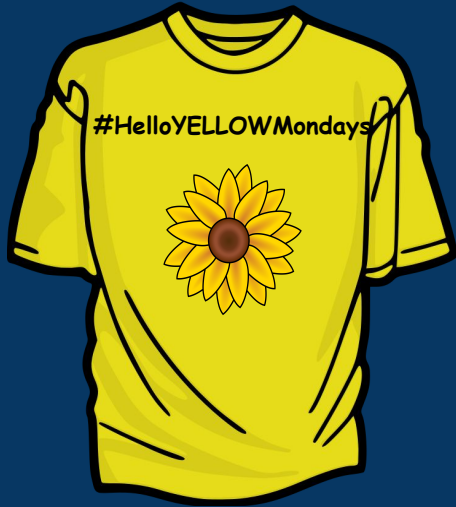
